PHA Obstacles Judging Criteria

The Obstacles course will consist of 8 obstacles. Each obstacle will be worth 5 points for a total of 40 possible points.

Points deductions (per obstacle)

1/2 point each minor tick of obstacle

1 point major hit, step on, or bite/grab of obstacle

Break of gait from walk, less than 2 steps

2 points skipping over, stepping out of, stepping off of, or not stepping fully into

obstacle

3 points 1 refusal of obstacle

Break of gait from walk more than 2 steps

4 points 2 refusals or obstacle

Dropping object required to be carried

Letting go of gate or rope gate

5 points 3 refusals of obstacle (should also result in Moving on to next obstacle)

Blatant disobedience

Failure to enter, exit, or perform obstacle

Failure to complete obstacle

Failure to work obstacle as instructed

No attempt to perform obstacle

Knocking down or severely disturbing obstacle

<u>Horsemanship</u> - to be judged on pair in between each obstacle. Worth 10 points total Points deduction (per times between obstacles)

1 point - horse walks too fast or too slow, not with Handler

Horse stops/pauses Rider is unbalanced

Horse breaks from walk less than 2 steps / Strides

3 points - horse breaks from walk more than 2 steps / strides

Disqualifications:

- 3 refused obstacles
- Failure to complete course
- Incorrect line of travel
- Dangerous reaction or behavior
- Fall from horse
